

TOLERANT TEN

AUTUMN SAGE *Salvia greggii*

HUMMINGBIRDS LOVE THE WHITE, PINK OR RED BLOOMS WHICH APPEAR FROM MARCH TO FROST. REACHES 3 FT.' TALL AND 3 FT. WIDE AND SHOULD BE PLANTED IN FULL SUN. EVERGREEN IN MILD WINTERS

RED YUCCA *Hesperaloe parviflora*

CORAL-RED SPIKES BLOOM FROM APRIL TO FROST. REACHES 3 FT. BY 3 FT. PLANT THIS EVERGREEN PERENNIAL IN FULL SUN. DROUGHT AND FROST TOLERANT.

PINK EVENING PRIMROSE *Oenothera speciosa*

BEARS LOVELY PINK BLOSSOMS FROM APRIL TO MAY AND REACHES 23 INCHES TALL. THIS RAPIDLY SPREADING PERENNIAL SHOULD BE PLANTED IN SUN TO PART-SHADE.

INDIAN BLANKET *Gaillardia aristata*

DRAMATIC CRIMSON AND YELLOW DAISY-LIKE BLOOMS APPEAR APRIL THROUGH MAY. REACHES 1 FT. TALL BY 2 FT. WIDE. PLANT THIS PERENNIAL IN FULL SUN.

BLUE SALVIA *Salvia farinacea*

SPIKY BLUE BLOOMS FROM APRIL TO FROST. REACHES 3 FT. TALL AND 2 FT. WIDE. PLANT THIS DROUGHT TOLERANT PERENNIAL IN SUN TO PART-SHADE.

TURK'S CAP *Malvaviscus drummondii*

RED, BLOOMS FROM JUNE TO FROST. REACHES 3 FT. BY 3 FT. FULL SUN TO SHADE. RED

GOLDEN COLUMBINE *Aquilegia chrysantha*

BEAUTIFULLY "SPURRED" YELLOW BLOOMS APPEAR FROM MARCH TO APRIL. REACHES 2 FT. TALL BY 2 FT. WIDE. PLANT THIS PERENNIAL IN SHADE TO PART SHADE.

FOUR NERVE DAISY *Hymenoxys scaposa*

CHEERFUL YELLOW BLOOMS APPEAR FROM MARCH TO FROST. GROWS 1 FT. TALL BY 2 FT. WIDE. EVERGREEN, PLANT IN FULL SUN.

TEXAS LANTANA *Lantana horrida*

BUTTERFLIES LOVE THE BRIGHT ORANGE BLOOMS WHICH APPEAR FROM JUNE TO FROST AND BIRDS LOVE THE FRUIT. THIS PERENNIAL REACHES 4 FT. TALL BY 4 FT. WIDE AND SHOULD BE PLANTED IN FULL SUN.

FLAME ACANTHUS *Anisicanthus quadrifidus*

ORANGE TUBULAR BLOSSOMS BLOOM CONTINUOUSLY FROM JULY TO FROST. SMALL DECIDUOUS SHRUB REACHES 3 FT. BY 3 FT. PLANT IN FULL SUN.
